

Passport application checklist (under 18)

The Norwegian Embassy in London

All documentation must be prepared before your appointment. See more on our website [Norway in the United Kingdom](#)

Information in the passport system is taken directly from the [National Population Register](#) (Folkeregisteret) and must be up to date before you can be issued a passport. This includes name, place of birth/country of birth, and citizenship. **Please ensure your information is up to date [here](#) or by contacting [Skatteetaten](#).**

Documentation required for minors (under 18)

- Application form** completed and printed before the appointment.
- Passport** (valid or expired).
 - You cannot renew the child's passport if you do not present their current passport.
 - If the passport expired more than 3 months ago you must also bring the original birth certificate (parents' names must appear).
- Consent given by both parents**
 - A parent with sole parental responsibility must accompany the child to the appointment.
 - See more information on our website under the tab '[Parental responsibility and consent](#)'.
- Original and valid passport (with signature) of the parent(s) attending the appointment**
 - If only one parent is attending the appointment, the other parent must give consent beforehand
- Proof of legal residency in the UK**
Bring one of the following:
 - EUSS '[share code](#)' to prove your status (EU Settlement Scheme)
 - Valid UK visa
 - Valid UK passport
- Credit or debit card (not American Express)** to pay the application fee.
 - Cash payments are not accepted.

When applying for a passport, the embassy must ensure that all requirements are met and that there are no legal obstructions to issuing a passport. This means that some applications can entail longer processing times.
